ABOUT THE SYMPOSIUM

The topic of the congress is a challenging one. Numerous books and articles have been published on when, why and how Pierre de Coubertin (1863 – 1937) has developed his vision of what has become popularly known as the Olympic Idea today. There is a lack of research on the evaluation of today's meaning and impact of Coubertin's Olympic vision and even more so for the future development of the Olympic Movement and Olympic sport. It is attempted to close this research gap at the symposium with speakers whose academic expertise in research on Coubertin and the Olympic Movement is well known internationally.
