During the last two decades, in China and Europe the mutual interest in the development of politics, economy and culture has increased. The growing awareness of changes in other continental settings has fostered communication and exchange in general and reinforced cross-border activities in the field of sports in particular. Against the backdrop of recent changes in sport, the conference will explore these developments from an academic perspective. Light will be shed on general trends in sport and physical activity, on case studies in different types of sport an on various Chinese urban areas. Since China is often perceived as a centralized state only limited attention has been paid to the peculiarities of the individual provinces and cities. Accordingly, the conference aims at exploring similarities and differences in the development of sport beyond and below the national level.


