Research Scientist

The position will be part-time (65%) as PhD or Post Doc, with a regular weekly working time of 25 hrs and 53 minutes, limited to 24 months (possibility of extending).

The position is certified for scientific qualification in accordance with the Wissenschaftszeitgesetz (Wiss-ZeitVG) and will be limited to two years. This time span is considered as being appropriate for the support of scientific qualification.

Employment is within the frame of the interdisciplinary research project "Moving in time and space – Do (a)symmetric time-space mappings depend on modality-specific processing?" (together with Prof. Rouven Cañal-Bruland, Department of Sport Psychology, Institute of Sport Science, Friedrich-Schiller-University Jena) and is sponsored by the German Research Foundation. The Department Performance Psychology of the Institute of Psychology allocates its several laboratories and technical support and offers an intensive training for postgraduates.

Tasks:

- Development and validation of an experimental paradigm to measure visual and auditory processing in motor tasks (e.g., catching a ball in virtual reality)
- Conducting and evaluating experiments
- Implementation of projects and publications

Expected are:

- Excellent university degree in science, preferably in psychology or sport science or other related disciplines
- Experience with experimental methods
- High willingness to learn

Desirable are:

- Motivated in scientific work within a research group
- Experience with kinematic methods
- Excellent English language skill written and oral
- Very good statistic- and programming skills (e.g., Matlab, Unity 3D)

The applicant with the required qualifications will be remunerated in accordance with salary group 13 TV-L / TVÜ-federal state.
