


## Timetable – the semester schedule for the Master's degrees

## **Getting started**

Once you have decided upon a Master's degree course, you can *easily* compile a model semester timetable by following the *listed instructions*:

- 1) The *homepage* (<u>Study plans</u>) lists all curricula of the individual master's degree courses. Select the latest issue of the curriculum for the master's degree that you are interested in.
- 2) Consider for *which semester you want to compile an exemplary timetable*. Since the Master's degree courses <u>only enrol once a year (winter term)</u> the following applies:



Find the modules for the corresponding semester and note the module descriptions.


 Click on LSF (Web application for teaching, studies and research) at: <u>www.dshs-koeln.de/english/studying-structure/other-topics/course-cataloguelsf</u> (link on the right side)



- 4) You do <u>not</u> have to log in, in order to use the course catalogue in LSF!
- 5) Select whether you want to list the offered courses for a (current or past) winter or summer semester. You can change the semester in the upper navigation bar.



6) Now select the tab "Courses" followed by "Course Overview" in the navigation bar.



- 7) Select the *chosen Master's degree course*. Here you have a complete course overview for the respective Master's degree course.
- 8) By using the prior *selected module descriptions* (from the curriculum), you can compile your individual *semester timetable*.
